CHAPTER 28.

AN ACT to legalize certain acts of the board of supervisors of the town of Wiota, in La Fayette county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. All the acts and doings of the board of supervisors of the town of Wiota, in the county of La Fayette, at a meeting held on the eleventh day of July, A. D. 1863, for the purpose of declaring and establishing the boundary lines of the several school districts in said town, are hereby legalized and confirmed, and shall have the same effect as though the conditions of law were in all respects complied with, in regard to calling and conducting said meeting.

Boundaries of school districts legalized.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
