

CHAPTER 409.

[Published April 28, 1864.]

AN ACT to authorize the village of Depere and the town of Lawrence to purchase or lease a certain bridge across Fox river, for a free bridge.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Authority to
purchase bridge,
&c.

SECTION 1. The village of Depere and the town of Lawrence, in the county of Brown, or either of the said corporations, are hereby authorized and empowered to purchase absolutely, or lease from the owners thereof, a certain bridge across the Fox river, at Depere, and all the appurtenances thereto belonging, and the charter of the same, granted by this state by an act of the legislature of said state, approved February 4, 1851, upon such terms as the parties in interest may agree to.

Stipulations de-
clared legal.

SECTION 2. All stipulations and agreements heretofore made between the said village of Depere and town of Lawrence, concerning the leasing of said bridge and appurtenances, are hereby declared valid and binding.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
