

## CHAPTER 88.

[Published February 27, 1864.]

AN ACT to extend the time for the collection of taxes in the city of Beloit, in the county of Rock.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. The time for the collection of taxes in the city of Beloit, in the county of Rock, is hereby extended until the twenty-fifth day of March, 1864: *provided*, that this act shall not be so construed as to extend the time for the payment of state taxes. Extended to  
March 25.

SECTION 2. The treasurer of said city shall have the same power and authority to collect the taxes contained in said city tax roll after as before such extension of time for the collection of said taxes, and the return of the city treasurer to the county treasurer, within the time limited for the collection of taxes by this act, shall be as valid if made pursuant to the direction of the original warrant. Collection and  
return of taxes.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 89.

[Published February 27, 1864.]

AN ACT to legalize the assessment roll of the town of Richwood, Richland county, Wisconsin, for the year 1863.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. The assessment roll of the town of Richwood, in Richland county, is hereby legalized for all the purposes of the assessment and collection of the taxes of said town for the year 1863. Legalized.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
