AN ACT to amend chapter 445 of the general laws of 1864, "an act to guard against the abuse of the elective franchise, and to preserve the purity of elections, by a registration of electors."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 445 of the general Amendment. laws of 1864, is hereby amended, by striking out of said section the following words where they occur, viz.: "In making said list, the board shall enter thereon, in addition to the names on the poll list, the names of all other persons who are well known to them to be electors in said district, and"
