

CHAPTER 38.

[Published April 11, 1866.]

AN ACT to authorize the distribution of certain documents and publications.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The secretary of state is hereby authorized and directed to forward to the several states which practice like comity with the state of Wisconsin, copies of all laws, journals, reports or other documents published by authority of the state. Laws, &c. to be sent to states.

SECTION 2. The secretary of state is hereby authorized and directed to annually forward to Washington, for the use of the congressional library, two copies of all volumes of local and general laws, supreme court reports, legislative journals, reports of departments, legislative manual, and other documents published by authority of the state. To be sent to congressional librarian.

SECTION 3. There is hereby annually appropriated Appropriation. out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, belonging to the general fund, a sum sufficient to carry into effect the provisions of this act.

CHAPTER 39.

[Published April 10, 1866.]

AN ACT to provide a home for the orphans of Wisconsin soldiers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. An institution is hereby established, the name of which shall be "the soldiers' orphans' home, of Wisconsin." "Soldiers' orphans' home."

SECTION 2. For the purpose of providing suitable buildings for said institution, the governor, secretary of state, state treasurer and attorney general are hereby Purchase of buildings, &c.
