

CHAPTER 41.

[Published February 27, 1869.]

AN ACT to legalize jury lists in Wood county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The list or lists of names selected by the county board of supervisors of Wood county on the 31st day of December, 1868, from which to draw jurors in and for said county for the year 1869, are hereby declared to be a legal jury list or lists for said county, and all persons drawn as jurors from said list or lists, or either of them, in the year 1869, shall be legal jurors and required to serve as such, precisely as if such list or lists had been made in conformity with the law relating to jury lists and jurors in force on the thirty-first day of December 1868. Legalized.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 42.

AN ACT to amend section 2 of chapter 170 of the general laws of 1867, entitled "an act to facilitate the recovery of judgments."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 170 of the general laws of 1867, entitled "an act to facilitate the recovery of judgments" is hereby repealed. Repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
