

CHAPTER 38.

[Published March 10, 1870.]

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter 110 of the general laws of 1867, entitled "an act to amend chapter 13 of the revised statutes, entitled 'of notaries public.'"

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Amended.

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter one hundred and ten of the general laws of 1867, is hereby amended by striking out the words, "to the governor," where they occur in the sixteenth line of said section, and inserting in the place thereof the words, "into the state treasury."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 39.

[Published March 11, 1870.]

AN ACT to provide for an additional institution for the insane.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Additional institution to be established.

SECTION 1. There shall be established as soon after the passage of this act as practicable, an additional state institution for the proper care and treatment of the insane.

Commissioners to locate institution to be appointed.

SECTION 2. For the purpose of the establishment, location and erection of the buildings of said institution, the governor is hereby authorized to appoint six persons, one from each congressional district, together with the medical superintendent of the Wisconsin state hospital for the insane, to constitute a board of commissioners, who shall meet at the state capital within
