

CHAPTER 90.

[Published March 18, 1871.]

AN ACT to amend chapter 55, general laws of 1870, entitled an act to amend chapter 19 of the revised statutes, entitled "of highways and bridges."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Amended.

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter 55 of the general laws of 1870 is hereby amended to read as follows: Section 25 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes, entitled "of highways and bridges," is hereby amended by inserting in the fifth line of the second clause, immediately after the word, "Sheboygan," the words, "Ashland, Bayfield, Burnett, Dallas, Douglas, Outagamie, Monroe, Marathon, Polk, Waupaca, Kewaunee, Door and Vernon."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

AN ACT to amend chapter 102 of the general laws of 1870, entitled "an act to authorize the secretary of state to purchase an index to the laws of the state of Wisconsin."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Sec.1 amended.

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter one hundred and two of the general laws of 1870 is hereby so amended as to read as follows: "Section 1. The secretary of state is hereby authorized and required to purchase two thousand copies of a synoptical index now being prepared by E. A. Spencer, which index
