CHAPTER 100.

AN ACT to amend chapter fifty-four, private and local laws of 1870, entitled "an act to authorize William A. Thomas to keep and maintain a bridge across Black river."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter fifty-four, private and local laws of 1870, entitled "an act to authorize William A. Thomas to keep and maintain a bridge across Black river," is hereby amended so as to read in the fifth line of said printed law, "number six (6) west of" instead of "number four (4) west of." ^{Amended.}

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 101.

AN ACT to restore Robert McAllister to the rights of citizenship.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Robert McAllister, of the town of Wrightstown, in Brown county, Wisconsin, is hereby restored to the rights of citizenship. ^{Restored.}

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
