

person committed to said jail for a violation of any ordinance, rule, order, resolution or by-law of said city, but such expenses shall be paid by the city.

SECTION 11. This act shall be considered a public act, and shall be construed favorably in all courts and places, and whenever in the same, any act or thing is directed or provided to be done, it shall be lawful to do and perform said act or thing, the same as though it were therein specifically authorized and declared to be lawful.

SECTION 12. An act entitled an act to amend an act entitled an act to incorporate the city of Mineral Point, approved March 2, 1857, and also, acts amendatory thereof, approved March 25, 1858, March 17, 1859, and March 2, 1860, approved March 16, 1861, and all acts amendatory thereof are hereby repealed.

SECTION 13. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 238.

[Published March 27, 1873.]

AN ACT to prescribe the powers, rights and duties of towns and cities holding stock in railway companies.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section seven of chapter one hundred and eighty-two of the general laws of 1872 is amended by adding to said section the following: The provisions of this section shall be held and deemed to apply to all cases where aid has been or hereafter may be voted and stock subscribed towards the construction of any railroad in this state, whether under the provisions of this act or any other law of a general or private nature.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
