

## CHAPTER 25.

[Published February 13, 1873.]

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and seventy-two of the general laws of 1872, entitled "an act to amend section four of chapter one hundred and forty-nine of the general laws of 1871, entitled 'an act to provide for the incorporation of the Wisconsin State Horticultural Society, and the printing and publishing of its transactions.'"

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Chapter one hundred and seventy-two <sup>Amended.</sup> of the general laws of 1872 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following, after section one: Section

2. There is hereby appropriated out of the general <sup>Appropriated.</sup> printing fund, the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars, to carry out the provisions of section one of this chapter.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 26.

[Published February 13, 1873.]

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter one hundred and one of the revised statutes entitled "of the payment of debts and legacies of deceased persons."

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter one hundred and <sup>Amended.</sup> one of the revised statutes entitled "of the payment of debts and legacies of deceased persons," is hereby amended by adding the following as subdivision three:

When it shall appear from the inventory that there is no property belonging to said estate except the home- <sup>How to proceed with final settlement of estates.</sup> stead, and that which is exempt from the payment of debts due from the deceased, and that to which the widow and children are entitled by law, and the administrator or executor shall petition for a final settle-
