

CHAPTER 303.

[Published March 27, 1873.]

AN ACT to amend chapter fifty-eight of the revised statutes, and the act amendatory thereto, entitled "of weights and measures."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1: Section eleven of chapter fifty-eight of the revised statutes, entitled "of weights and measures," ^{Amended—the legal weights of grains, etc., fixed.} as amended by chapter one hundred and twenty-five of the general laws of 1868, and chapter twelve of the general laws of 1872, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 11. Whenever wheat, rye, Indian corn, oats, barley, clover seed, buckwheat, dried apples, dried peaches, flax seed, timothy seed, potatoes, parsnips, turnips, (common flat), beets, carrots, onions or ruta bagas, shall be sold by the bushel, and no special agreement as to the measure or weight thereof shall be made by the parties, the measure thereof shall be ascertained by weight, and shall be computed as follows: sixty pounds for a bushel of wheat or clover seed; fifty-six pounds for a bushel of rye or Indian corn, shelled, and seventy pounds of Indian corn, unshelled; thirty-two pounds for a bushel of oats; forty-eight pounds for a bushel of barley; fifty pounds for a bushel of buckwheat; twenty-eight pounds for a bushel of dried apples or dried peaches; fifty-six pounds for a bushel of flax seed; forty-six pounds for a bushel of timothy seed; sixty pounds for a bushel of potatoes; forty-four pounds for a bushel of parsnips; forty-two pounds for a bushel of common flat turnips; fifty pounds for a bushel of beets; fifty pounds for a bushel of carrots; fifty pounds for a bushel of onions, and fifty-six pounds for a bushel of ruta bagas.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
