

CHAPTER 8.

[Published February 3, 1873.]

AN ACT to provide for the purchase of sundry copies of Taylor's
Compilation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The secretary of state is hereby authorized to purchase for the use of the state, such number of copies of the statutes of Wisconsin, as compiled by David Taylor, not exceeding one hundred, as may be necessary for the use of the legislature, upon such terms and conditions as may be most advantageous to the state. May purchase Taylor's Compilation.

SECTION 2. The sum of six hundred and seventy-five dollars is hereby appropriated from the state treasury in order to carry out the provisions of this act. Appropriated.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 9.

AN ACT to legalize the action of the supervisors of the towns of Etrick and Gale, in the county of Trempealeau, in the alteration and division of joint school district number six of said towns, and the formation by the town of Etrick of school district number nine of said town.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The action and proceedings of the town board of supervisors of the towns of Etrick and Gale, in Trempealeau county, in the alteration and division of joint school district number six of said towns, and the action and proceedings of the town board of supervisors of the town of Etrick, in said county, in the Action and proceedings legalized.
