

CHAPTER 334.

AN ACT to legalize the acts and proceedings of certain town meetings held in the town of Anson, Chippewa county, during the year 1873, and the acts of the board of supervisors of said town in accordance therewith.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. All the acts and proceedings of a town meeting held in the town of Anson, in the county of Chippewa, on the first day of July, 1873, in the election of a bridge committee to superintend and supervise the erection of a bridge across the Chippewa river, between the town of Anson and the town of Eagle Point, are hereby legalized and made valid and binding in all respects. a Town meeting legalized.

SECTION 2. All the acts and proceedings of a town meeting held in the town of Anson, in the county of Chippewa, on the twenty-third day of October, 1873, for the purpose of voting bonds to aid in the erection of a bridge across the Chippewa river, between the town of Anson and the town of Eagle Point, in said county, and the acts of the board of supervisors of the said town of Anson in issuing bonds in accordance with the vote of said meeting, are hereby legalized and made valid and binding in all respects. Acts of town meeting legalized.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
