

CHAPTER 62.

AN ACT to legalize the official acts of L. R. Rockwell, a notary public of Columbia county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The official acts of L. R. Rockwell, a notary public in Columbia county, are hereby declared to be lawful, notwithstanding an intermission existed between the expiration of a former commission and the date of his present commission.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 63.

AN ACT to legalize the tax roll of the town of Oconto for the year 1873.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The assessment roll and tax list and warrant for the collection of taxes in the town of Oconto, for the collection of taxes for the year 1873, are hereby declared legal and valid in all respects for the collection of taxes upon both real and personal property. Assessment of 1873 legalized.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
