

CHAPTER 62.

[Published February 26, 1875.]

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money therein named to the institution for the education of the blind for current expenses.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation. SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated, out of any money in the general fund not otherwise appropriated, the sum of eighteen thousand dollars, for the payment of current expenses at the institution for the education of the blind, for the year 1875.

To be drawn quarterly. SECTION 2. All sums of money for current expenses shall be drawn from the treasury not oftener than quarterly, in advance.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 63.

[Published February 26, 1875.]

AN ACT to appropriate to the Northern Hospital for the Insane a sum of money therein named, for current expenses.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation. SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Northern Hospital for the Insane, out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of fifty-five thousand dollars, for current expenses for the year 1875, to be drawn not oftener than quarterly, in advance.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
