

CHAPTER 202.

[Published April 4, 1876.]

AN ACT to provide for the erection and maintaining of a slaughter house in the village of Delavan.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The president and board of trustees of the villages of Delavan and Elkhorn may, in their discretion, allow the erection and maintaining of a slaughter house or slaughter houses within the corporate limits of said villages not nearer than twenty-five (25) rods to any residence or place of public business, any law of this state to the contrary notwithstanding. Authority to erect slaughter houses.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 203.

AN ACT to amend chapter eighteen (18), of the general laws of 1871, entitled, "An act to provide for holding normal institutes in the State of Wisconsin, and to appropriate a certain sum of money for the purposes therein named."

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section two (2), of chapter eighteen (18), of the general laws of 1871, entitled, "An act to provide for holding normal institutes in the State of Wisconsin, and to appropriate a certain sum of money for the purposes therein named," is hereby amended so as to read as follows; Each of said institutes shall be held for at least two (2) consecutive weeks, under the direction of the county superintendent, assisted by such person or persons as the state superintendent may appoint. Holding of institutes.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
