

CHAPTER 292.

AN ACT to legalize the salary of the register of deeds of the county of Barron.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Acts legalized. SECTION 1. The act or acts of the county board of supervisors of Barron county, in fixing the salary of the register of deeds of said county, by resolution, at the meeting of said board of supervisors held on the 11th day of November, A. D. 1875, are hereby legalized and declared to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 293.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and thirteen (113), of the private and local laws of 1867, and chapter four hundred and two (402), of the private and local laws of 1869, relating to the village of Shullsburg.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Amended. SECTION 1. Section 1, of chapter one hundred and thirteen (113), of the private and local laws of 1867, entitled, "An act to amend chapter one hundred and fifteen (115), of the private and local (general) laws of 1861, entitled, 'an act to incorporate the village of Shullsburg,'" is hereby amended by striking out all after the word "have," in said section 1, and inserting in lieu thereof as follows: "Concurrent jurisdiction with the justice of the peace provided for in chapter 319, of the general laws of 1864."

Amended. SECTION 2. Section one of chapter four hundred and two, of the private and local laws of 1869, is hereby amended by striking out all of said section one, after the word "roads," in the last line of said section one, and inserting in lieu thereof the words, "streets, bridges, or sidewalks in said village."
