

SECTION 2. The proof of such settlement and cultivation as referred to in said section fourteen, may be filed with the commissioners of school and university lands, and such proof may be made by affidavit, which shall be *prima facie* evidence of the facts therein stated.

Proof of settlement to be filed.

SECTION 3. It is hereby declared to be the true intent and meaning of said section fourteen, that any party entitled to land under said section may acquire land, not exceeding a quarter section.

Meaning of act.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect on and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 393.

AN ACT to authorize the Columbus Union Fair Agricultural Society to file reports, and for other purposes.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The Columbus Union Fair Agricultural Society are hereby authorized to file with the secretary of state their annual report and make any and all reports required of them under the laws of this state in relation to their annual fair for 1875, and their reports are hereby declared to have the same force and effect as though made at the time required by law.

Report may be made without reference to time.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
