

orized and empowered to keep an office and transact any and all business of said town, at such place or places within the limits of the city of Waupaca, in said county, as said board of supervisors, by an order entered in their minutes, determine.

SECTION 2. Any general or special election, and any annual or special town meeting of said town of Waupaca, hereafter ordered or held, may be held at such places within the limits of the city of Waupaca as the board of supervisors of said town may determine: *provided*, the notice of said election or town meeting shall specify the place where the same will be held; and any such election or town meeting of the said town of Waupaca, so held within the limits of the said city of Waupaca, shall be as legal and binding in all respects as the same would be if held within the limits of the said town, anything in the laws of this state to the contrary notwithstanding.

Elections may be held in city of Waupaca.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 75.

AN ACT to repeal chapter three hundred and thirty-eight of the private and local laws of one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine, relating to the town of La Prairie, in the county of Rock, doing work in the town of Harmony, in said county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter three hundred and thirty-eight of the private and local laws of one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine, entitled "An act to authorize the town of La Prairie, in the county of Rock, to do work upon a certain highway, located in the town of Harmony, in said county," is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
