CHAPTER 223.

AN ACT to provide for the sale of certain Wisconsin reports.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The state librarian is hereby authorized to sell the second hand Wisconsin reports, consisting of forty volumes belonging to the state, and now in the possession of Romanzo Bunn, late circuit judge of the sixth judicial circuit, for a sum not less than one dollar and fifty cents per volume, in cash. Rate per volume.

SECTION 2. This act shall be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 224.

AN ACT to repeal sections one, two and three of chapter one hundred and sixty-eight of the private and local laws of 1854, relating to the construction and maintaining of a flume in the second ward of the city of Milwaukee.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Sections one, two and three of chapter one hundred and sixty-eight of the private and local laws of 1854, entitled an act to amend an act entitled an act to consolidate and amend an act to incorporate the city of Milwaukee, and the several acts amendatory thereof, is hereby repealed. Repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
