CHAPTER 31.

AN ACT to amend section 1336, revised statutes, in relation to encroachments.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1336 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the following: Relating to encroachments. Either party to such proceeding may appeal to the circuit court of the proper county from the verdict or determination of the jury, and the matters therein shall be tried in the circuit court as an original action brought in said court. Such appeal shall be made in the manner and within the time now fixed by law for making appeals from judgments of justices of the peace. So that when amended said section will read as follows: If the jury find that no encroachment has been made they shall so certify, and shall also ascertain and certify the damages which the occupant shall have sustained by such proceedings; which damages, together with the costs of the proceedings, shall be paid by the supervisors, and shall be a charge in their favor against the town in which they shall have been elected. Either party to such proceeding may appeal to the circuit court of the proper county from the verdict or determination of the jury, and the matters therein shall be tried as an original action brought in said court. Such appeal shall be made in the manner and within the time now fixed by law for making appeals from judgments of justices of the peace.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 32.

AN ACT to amend chapter 61 of the revised statutes, entitled "of general provisions in aid of agriculture."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1472 of chapter 61 of the revised statutes, entitled "of general provisions in aid of agriculture," is hereby amended by adding after the word "lands" in the seventh line "or for Culture of cranberries.
