CHAPTER 110.

AN ACT to amend section 2433, chapter 113, of the revised statutes, entitled, "Of court commissioners," as amended by chapter 151, of the laws of 1881, and chapter 107, of the laws of 1883.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. Section 2433, of the revised statutes, ^{Amended.} as amended by chapter 151, laws of 1881, and chapter 107, of the laws of 1883, is hereby amended by adding to said section the words, "five such court commissioners may be appointed in the county of Milwaukee."

SECTION 2. This act shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 111.

AN ACT to amend chapter 119, of the revised statutes of Wisconsin of 1878, entitled, "Of the place of trial of civil actions."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. Subdivision 4th, of section 2619, of the revised statutes, is hereby amended so as to ^{Trials and place of actions.} read as follows: 4th. Of an action, except appeals in condemnation proceedings, against any railroad corporation, as defined by section 1861, any county through or into which the railroad owned or operated by such corporation runs.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
