CHAPTER 135.

AN ACT to amend section 1, of chapter 52, of the laws of 1879, entitled, "An act to regulate the time for holding the general terms of the circuit court in the Eighth Judicial Circuit, and to authorize the circuit judge of said court to appoint special terms therein."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Terms of court
changed.

SECTION 1. Section 1, of an act entitled, "An act to regulate the time for holding the general terms of the circuit court in the eighth judicial circuit, and to authorize the circuit judge of said court to appoint special terms therein," approved, February 21, 1879, is hereby amended by striking out the words, "third Monday" in the last line of said section, and inserting in lieu thereof the words, "second Monday," so that said section shall read: Section 1. The general terms of the circuit court in the eighth judicial circuit, shall be held as follows: In the county of Buffalo, on the fourth Monday of February and on the fourth Monday of October; in the county of Dunn, on the second Monday of March and on the second Monday of September; in the county of Eau Claire, on the fourth Monday of March and on the fourth Monday of September; in the county of Pepin, on the third Monday of April and on the third Monday of October; in the county of Pierce, on the second Monday of June and on the second Monday of December; in the county of St. Croix, on the second Monday of May and on the second Monday of November.

SECTION 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 1885.
