CHAPTER 95.

AN ACT to authorize the common council of the city of Watertown to levy a tax for the purpose of building a city hall.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Tax authorized
for city hall.

SECTION 1. Section 2, of chapter 5, of chapter 233, of the laws of 1865, entitled, an act to consolidate and amend an act to incorporate the city of Watertown, and the several acts amendatory thereof, is hereby amended by adding to said section the following: The said common council is authorized to levy a tax, not to exceed eight mills on the dollar, upon all the property liable to taxation in said city, towards the building of a city hall; provided, that the amount so levied and collected, as authorized by this act, shall be appropriated to no purpose, except such as specified in this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
