lease to any other heir his interest therein, which release, when made, shall be filed in the office of the town or city clerk within which such cemetery shall be situated. The body of any deceased person shall not be interred in any such lot, unless it be the body of a person having at the time of such decease an interest therein, or a relative, or the husband or wife of such person, or his or her relative, except by the consent of all persons having an interest in such lot.

CHAPTER 217.

AN ACT to amend section 2, of chapter 421, laws of 1885, entitled, "an act relating to town insurance companies," and amendatory of section 2, chapter 48, of the laws of 1881.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2, of chapter 421, laws of Amending ch. 1885, is hereby amended by inserting after the 421, laws 1885 words, "water-mills," in the thirty-first line of said section, the words, "and cheese factories," so that said section when so amended, shall read as follows: Section 2. No such corporation shall insure any property out of the town or towns in which such corporation is located; provided, that any such corporation at its annual meeting, may by a majority vote of the members present authorize its directors to insure any farm property or detached dwelling house and contents in any adjoining town or towns; or in any incorporated city or village which is located in any adjoining towns in which such town insurance corporation is located; provided, such farm property or dwelling or contents shall be detached at least one hundred feet from exposure. No such cor-

poration shall insure any property other than detached dwellings and their contents, farm build. ings and their contents, live stock in possession or running at large, farm products on premises and farming implements; provided, that no loss of any live stock insured by such corporation shall be recoverable, if occurring while such stock was kept or confined in any building which such corporation could not insure under this section. But such corporation at its annual meeting, may, by a majority of all the votes cast by its members present, authorize its directors to insure country stores and their contents, school-houses, churches, town and society halls, country hotels, water-mills and cheese factories, but such risks shall not exceed twenty-five hundred dollars in any one

CHAPTER 218.

AN ACT to authorize J. C. Schneider and William Wilson to maintain a dam across the Rice Bed stream, a fork of Apple river, in Polk county, Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Authorizing J. SECTION 1. John C. Schneider and William Wil-C. Schneider, et al., to maintain son, their heirs and assigns, are hereby authorized dam on Apple to maintain and keep up a dam across the Rice river, Polk Bed stream, a branch of Apple river, in Polk SECTION 1. John C. Schneider and William Wil-Bed stream, a branch of Apple river, in Polk county, Wisconsin, at a point on the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter of section six, in township thirty-four, of range fifteen west; provided, that such dam shall not raise the water to exceed six feet.
