CHAPTER 296.

AN ACT to vacate and discontinue a portion of a state road in the town of Sparta, in Monroe county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Vacating portion of a certain road in Monroe county.

SECTION 1. The order of the board of supervisors of the town of Sparta, in Monroe county, dated December 13, 1883, by which it was intended, as appears, by said order to discontinue a highway in said town described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the east line of the city of Sparta, at the east end of Pine street, or a continuation of Pine street, in the north-east quarter of the south-east quarter of section thirteen, town seventeen north, of range four west, running thence east eighty rods to the east line of the town of Sparta (said highway being known as the Portage road) crossing the north-east quarter of the south-east quarter of said section thirteen, and the acts of the said board of supervisors in relation thereto are hereby legalized, and all that part of said highway or road known as the "Portage road," being and running between the east line of the city of Sparta and the east line of the said town of Sparta is hereby vacated and discontinued.

SECTION 2. This act shall be in force from and after its passage and publication.
