## CHAPTER 180.

AN ACT to amend chapter 163, of the laws of 1887, entitled, "an act to incorporate the city of Barron," and to define the boundaries of said city.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Chapter 1, of chapter 163, of the laws of 1887, is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

## CHAPTER I.

## INCORPORATION.

SECTION 1. All that district of country known and described as the northwest quarter of section twenty-six, sections twenty-seven and twenty-eight, township thirty-four, range twelve, in the town of Barron, county of Barron and state of Wisconsin, is hereby set off from said town, and the said district of country shall be a city by the name of Barron, and the people now inhabiting and who shall hereafter inhabit the said district of country shall be a municipal corporation by the name of the "city of Barron," have the general powers possessed by municipal corporations at common law, and in addition thereto shall possess the powers hereinafter specifically granted, and the authorities thereof shall have perpetual succession; shall be capable of contracting and being contracted with, of suing and being sued, pleading and being impleaded in all courts of law and equity; shall be capable of purchasing, receiving, holding, occupying and conveying real and personal property; shall have a common seal, and may change the same at pleasure.

Supervisors.

SECTION 2. At the annual election for ward and city officers in said city of Barron, there shall be elected in the manner in which aldermen are elected in said city, one supervisor from each ward who shall represent his ward in the county board of supervisors, and in his absence or inability to

attend any session of the county board, the common council shall have power to appoint some suitable and qualified person from his ward to serve in that capacity.

SECTION 3. Section 7, of chapter 4, of chapter 163, of the laws of 1887, and any provisions of said chapter 163, conflicting with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

Repealed.

SECTION 4. Section 5, of chapter 7, of chapter 163, of the laws of 1887, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following: The common council shall also have power by order, ordinance, rule, resolution, regulation or by-law. Subsection 38. To regulate saloons, bar rooms, billiard and pool rooms and places for the sale or giving away of liquors or drinks, to regulate or restrain sales therein, and to prevent the same from being frequented or visited by minors, spendthrifts and persons to whom the sale of intoxicating liquors is prohibited. Subsection 39. To restrain, prohibit and suppress all descriptions of card playing, games and gaming in saloons and other public places in the city of Barron, and all descriptions of gambling and fraudulent devices and practices in said city. Subsection 40. To license and regulate hackmen, draymen, cartmen, porters and omnibus drivers, cabmen and carmen, whether in the employment of any corporation or otherwise, and any others who pursue like occupations, with or without vehicles, and to prescribe their compensation.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
