CHAPTER 185.

AN ACT to extend the time for the making, hearing and determination of motions for new trials, filing exceptions and taking other proceedings in actions tried at the January, 1889, term of the circuit court for the second judicial circuit, and to relieve parties in said court from certain effects of chapter 50, of the laws of 1889.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. In any action heretofore tried in the circuit court for the second judicial circuit during the term thereof begun in the month of January, 1889, and in which a verdict shall have been rendered by a jury, a motion for a new trial thereof may be made and exceptions to the judge's charge may be filed, and any and all proceedings now re-

quired by law to be had or taken therein at the same term at which such action was tried may be had or taken, at any time before the first Monday in May, 1889; and every such motion or proceeding in such action, and any motion for a new trial heretofore made in any such action and not decided prior to March 4, 1889, shall be heard and determined by the judge of said court at any time prior to said first Monday in May, 1889, in the same manner and with the same force and effect as though done at the said January, 1889, term; and any and all exceptions to the judge's charge in any such action, filed in the office of the clerk of said court after the second day of March, 1889, and before the first Monday in May, 1889, shall have the same force and effect as though filed during the said January term of said court; and for the purposes of making any such motion or filing such exceptions or taking any such proceeding, and of the hearing and determination of such motions, the said circuit court shall be deemed open at all times until said first Monday in May, 1889, as of the said January term of said court, chapter 50, of the laws of 1885, to the contrary notwithstanding.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 186.

AN ACT to amend section 3164, of revised statutes of 1878, relating to interest.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Amending section 3164, R. S., relating to interest, judgments in foreclosure.

SECTION 1. Section 3164, of the revised statutes of the state of Wisconsin, is hereby amended by striking out the words, "of ten per centum per annum," where they occur in the second line in said section, and inserting in place thereof, the
