CHAPTER 43.

AN ACT to amend section 1, of chapter 1, of chapter 148, of the private and local laws of 1887, entitled, "an act to revise, consolidate and amend the act to incorporate the city of Prescott," and the several acts amendatory thereof.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

Section 1. Section 1, of chapter 1, of chapter 148, of the private and local laws of 1887, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Chapter 1. Section 1. All that district of country situate in the county of Pierce, and embraced in the following boundaries, to-wit: Commencing on the Mississippi river, on the line running north and south through the center of the west half of section fourteen, in township twenty-six north, of range twenty west; thence north on said line through the center of the west half of sections fourteen and eleven to the section line on the north side of said section eleven; thence west along the north line of sections eleven and ten to the quarter post standing at the center of said section ten; thence north along the center line of section three, eighty rods; thence west parallel with the north line of said section ten to the center of Lake St. Croix; thence down the center of Lake St. Croix and the Mississippi river to a point opposite the place of beginning; thence northeasterly to the place of beginning, shall be known and designated as the "city of Prescott."
