CHAPTER 8.

AN ACT to fix the time for holding terms of court in the Seventh judicial circuit.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The terms of circuit court for the Seventh judicial circuit shall be held as follows: Terms of the circuit court in seventh judicial circuit.

For the county of Marathon, the first Monday in May and the first Monday in November.

For the county of Lincoln, the first Monday in March and the second Monday in October.

For the county of Portage, the third Monday in November and the fourth Monday in March.

For the county of Waupaca, the third Monday in January and the second Monday in June.

For the county of Waushara, the third Tuesday in April and the last Tuesday in September.

For the county of Wood, the fourth Monday in May and the second Monday in December; provided,

that in the year 1891 the terms of court in Lincoln county shall be held on the second Monday in July and on the second Monday in October, and actions, motions or proceedings already noticed or ordered for trial or hearing at the term of court to be held under the existing law in the county of Marathon, on the first Monday in March, 1891, shall be considered as being for trial or hearing at the term held according to this act, in Marathon county, on the first Monday in May, 1891, and jurors or witnesses subpoenaed, drawn or summoned to attend at the term in Marathon county, held on the first Monday in March, 1891, shall attend at the term commencing on the first Monday in May, by the terms of this act, without further notice or service of process. There shall be no term held in Lincoln county in March, 1891. Actions, motions or proceedings already noticed for trial in March, 1891, shall be for trial or hearing first Monday in May, 1891.

Every general term in each of said counties shall be a special term for all the other counties in said circuit.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication. No term in Lincoln county in March, 1891.
