CHAPTER 204.

AN ACT to appropriate to Joseph Filz a sum of money therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation
to Joseph Filz.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to Joseph Filz, out of any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of eight hundred and ninety-one dollars and fifty-one cents, in full for expenses incurred by him in contesting for the office of member of assembly of the district comprised of the county of Kewaunee.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
