CHAPTER 41.

AN ACT relating to fees of county and municipal judges in proceedings to determine insanity.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

When fees not
to be charged.

SECTION 1. Every county or municipal judge of counties whose population exceeds two hundred thousand shall not charge or receive the fees or compensation mentioned in section 593, of the Revised Statutes of 1878, and the acts amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, as payable to such judges for proceedings to determine insanity.

SECTION 2. All acts or parts of acts contravening the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
