CHAPTER 310.

AN ACT to amend section 837, of the revised statutes relating to town treasurers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

How town treasurers shall pay and keep a record of orders.

SECTION 1. That subdivision fourth of section 837, of the revised statutes, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: The amount of moneys raised for all other town purposes shall be applied to the payment of all other lawful orders upon the town treasury. The treasurer shall keep a record of all such orders presented to him for payment showing the date and order of presentation, the number, date, amount and name of drawee, and shall endorse upon such orders so presented the fact and date of presentation for payment and sign his name thereto, and as said orders are paid note the fact of payment on said record; said orders shall be paid in the order of their presentation as shown by said record when there are funds in the treasury.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
