**CHAPTER 236.**

**AN ACT** granting to the United States, jurisdiction over certain lands in Rock county.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

**SECTION 1.** The consent of the state of Wisconsin is hereby given to the purchase, by the United States, of any tract or tracts of land in the city of Janesville and county of Rock, for the erection of a building under the provisions of an act of congress approved March 2nd, 1899, entitled, "an act to provide for the construction of a public building at the city of Janesville, Wisconsin," and the state hereby cedes to the United States, exclusive jurisdiction over such tract or tracts of land as shall be purchased for the purpose aforesaid, so long as they shall be or remain the owner thereof, for all purposes except the service of civil and criminal process therein.

Jurisdiction granted except for service of civil and criminal process.

**SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication.
