

Right to amend or repeal reserved. SECTION 4. The right to amend or repeal this act is hereby reserved to the legislature.

Conflicting laws repealed. SECTION 5. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with or contravening the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 262.

AN ACT to authorize W. H. Dick, his associates and assigns, to build dams and make improvements on the Lilly river.

The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:

Location and purpose of dam. SECTION 1. For the purpose of improving the Lilly river in Langlade and Forest counties, for log-driving purposes W. H. Dick, his associates and assigns, are hereby authorized to maintain dams and wing dams, blast rocks, straighten the channel and make such other improvements as in their judgment will improve the stream for log-driving purposes from the mouth of the said river to the north line of town thirty-four. There shall be maintained in said dams suitable slides for the passage of fish.

Rates chargeable for passage of logs. SECTION 2. As compensation for the use of the said improvements, W. H. Dick, his associates and assigns, shall be entitled to charge, collect and receive twenty-five cents per thousand feet, board measure, for each thousand feet of logs or timber driven out of the said river and shall have a lien upon the same for the said sum which may be collected as charges for labor are collected.

Right to amend or repeal reserved. SECTION 3. The legislature reserves the right to amend or repeal this act.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication.
