

well those which have already accrued as those which shall accrue hereafter, saving only from its operation those which are now barred by any statute of limitations in force at the time of the passage of this act.

Conflicting laws repealed. SECTION 3. All acts and parts of acts, whether general or special, in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 2.

AN ACT to provide for the enrollment of laws, resolutions and memorials.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Enrolled bills; resolutions; memorials; how printed. SECTION 1. There is hereby enacted a new section of the statutes of 1898, known as section 320b, to read as follows: Section 320b. In place of the enrollment of bills, joint resolutions and memorials, as now practiced, each bill, joint resolution and memorial, upon its final passage, before being presented to the governor for approval, shall be printed by the state printer upon 40 pound ledger medium paper, the size of paper to be nine by eleven and one half inches, the printed page six by eight and one half inches, and the matter set in fourteen point roman type.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
