CHAPTER 366.

AN ACT relating to the place of trial of actions against the state and the state officers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Place of trial. SECTION 1. The place of trial of all actions authorized to be brought against the state or any of the state officers in their official capacity shall be Dane county.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 367.

AN ACT to appropriate to Edward E. Sater the sum of money herein mentioned.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Purpose of appropriation. SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund of the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of five hundred (500) dollars to Edward E. Sater, in full for injuries sustained and received by him November 2nd, 1904; by being thrown and falling, without fault or negligence on his part, while engaged as an electrician in wiring the capitol building and the park surrounding the same, the said injury being caused by the breaking of a certain defective electric light pole.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
