CHAPTER 71.

AN ACT to amend section 1659 of the statutes of 1898 to provide fees for the state sealer of weights and measures.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

State sealer and seal; fees. SECTION 1. Section 1659 of the statutes of 1898 is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 1659. The custody of said standards is given to the department of engineering of the state university, subject to the control of the board of regents thereof, and the professor of engineering shall be the state sealer of weights and measures. He shall keep a seal which shall be so formed as to impress the letters "Wis." upon the weights and measures, scales and beams sealed by him, with which he shall seal all authorized public standard weights and measures, scales and beams provided by the several counties, when tried and proved to be in conformity to the standard weights and measures, scales and beams aforesaid. *He shall be entitled to receive a fee of ten cents for the testing and sealing of each weight, measure, scale and beam tested and sealed by him.*

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
