CHAPTER 248.

AN ACT to create section 1797m—109 of the statutes, relating to the signing of notices by the Railroad Commission of Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is added to the statutes one new section to read: Section 1797m—109. Whenever the Railroad Commission of Wisconsin is required to issue notices of investigation, notices of hearing or to certify to copies of the records of the Commission, such notices or certification may be issued by any member of the Commission or by the Secretary of the Commission.

All acts or parts of acts conflicting with any provisions of this act are repealed insofar as they are inconsistent therewith.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 249.

AN ACT to create section 925—46m of the statutes, relating to the publication of the official proceedings of boards of education.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is added to the statutes a new section to read: Section 925—46m. The official proceedings of regular and special meetings of boards of education in all incorporated cities and villages in this state, including a full statement of all receipts and expenditures shall be printed and published in such manner as the board of education shall direct.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
