

for such purpose may erect piers, drive piles, build embankments and approaches in said river and on the banks thereof, suitable and necessary for the proper construction and maintenance of said bridge, and enjoy all the rights hereby granted or intended to be granted.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 46.

AN ACT to amend subdivision (b) of subsection 1, of section 4562d of the statutes, relating to the hunting of deer.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subdivision (b) of subsection 1 of section 4562d of the statutes is amended to read: (Section 4562d) 1. (b) Any deer in the counties of Grant, LaFayette, Green, Rock, Walworth, Kenosha, Racine, Milwaukee, Waukesha, Jefferson, Dane, Iowa, Crawford, Richland, Sauk, Columbia, Dodge, Buffalo, Washington, Ozaukee, Sheboygan, Fond du Lac, Green Lake, Pepin, Marquette, Adams, Vernon, Monroe, La Crosse, Wau-shara, Winnebago, Calumet, Manitowoc, Outagamie, Brown, Door, Kewaunee, Portage and Waupaca at any time; and in the county of Wood until November tenth, 1916.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 47.

AN ACT to appropriate to James Larsen, member of assembly from Marinette county, a certain sum of money as salary and mileage.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of five hundred forty-nine dollars and twenty cents to James Larsen, of Marinette, Wisconsin, as his salary and mileage as member of the assembly for the years 1913 and 1914.
