CHAPTER 27.

AN ACT to amend sections 3 and 13 of chapter 372 of the private and local laws of 1856 as amended by chapter 33 of the private and local laws of 1862, relating to the Herman Farmers' Mutual Insurance Company.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Sections 3 and 13 of chapter 372 of the private and local laws of 1856 as amended by chapter 33 of the private and local laws of 1862 are amended to read: Section 3. Every person who shall at any time become interested in said company, by insuring therein, and also his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, continuing to be insured therein, as hereafter or hereinafter mentioned, shall be deemed and taken to be members thereof, for and during the terms specified in their respective policies, and no longer; and shall at all times be concluded and bound by the provisions of this act, and the property and concerns of said corporation shall be managed and conducted by a board of eight directors, and that B. Ringle, Frederick Rissman, William Detner, William Degner, John Hils, John Suttenger, Casper George, and Charles Walter, shall be the first directors of said corporation, until others are chosen, and no longer. The directors shall be elected on the second day of January, in each year, at such hour of the day, * * * in the county of Dodge and state of Wisconsin and in such manner as the above named board of directors, after the passage of this act, shall direct, of which public notice shall be given, in one or more of the public newspapers, printed in the county of Dodge, and by posting up a notice in three of the most public places in the * * * county aforesaid, at least thirty days preceding such election, and such election shall be holden under the inspection of three members, not being directors, to be appointed previous to every election, by the board of directors, and such election shall be made by ballot, and by a plurality of the votes of the members then present, allowing one vote to each member, which shall be insured in said company.

SECTION 13. The operations and business of the Herman farmers' mutual insurance company, shall be carried on in the * * * state of Wisconsin, and its office and principal place of business shall be in the county of Dodge.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
