### CHAPTER 632

AN ACT to amend subsection (1) of section 20.05 of the statutes, relating to the state treasurer, and making an appropriation.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Subsection (1) of section 20.05 of the statutes is amended to read:

(20.05) (1) Annually, beginning July 1, \* \* \* 1917, \* \* \* *twenty-six thousand four hundred* dollars for the execution of his functions. Of this there is allotted:

(a) To the state treasurer an annual salary of five thousand dollars.

(b) To the assistant state treasurer an annual salary of two thousand five hundred dollars.

SECTION 2. Any unexpended balance remaining in the appropriation made by subsection (1) of section 20.05 on July 1, 1917, shall revert to the general fund.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon July 1, 1917.

### CHAPTER 633

AN ACT to repeal paragraph (1) of subsection 2 of Section 1728a—3; and to create a new paragraph of subsection 2 of Section 1728a—3 of the statutes, relating to child labor.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Paragraph (1) of subsection 2 of section 1728a—3 of the statutes is repealed.

SECTION 2. A new paragraph is added to subsection 2 of section 1728a—3 of the statutes to read:

(Section 1728a—3.2) (1) Such evidence as is required by the industrial commission showing that such child is at least fourteen years of age. The industrial commission shall formulate and publish rules and regulations governing the proof
