CHAPTER 164.

AN ACT to amend subsection (3) of section 70.32 of the statutes, relating to valuation of real estate for assessment purposes.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (3) of section 70.32 of the statutes is amended to read: (70.32) (3) In determining the value of lands used for agricultural * * * purposes there shall not be considered the element of enhancement of such value by reason of clearing such lands of stumps, stones or growing timber for a period of three years following any such clearing completed before January 1, * * * 1933.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 165.

AN ACT authorizing the adjutant general to receive from the secretary of war of the United States such "other funds" remaining to the credit of national guard units of this state.

WHEREAS, It has been duly made known to the proper authorities of this state that the secretary of war of the United States has in his possession, as trustee, certain moneys known as "other funds" which had been collected for their own use and benefit by certain national guard organizations that were broken up as units for or as a result of service in the world war, and have not been reconstituted; and

WHEREAS, It further appears that the secretary of war, as trustee, desires to turn over to a substitute trustee, duly authorized by this state, such portion of the said funds as equitably belong to the national guard of this state. Now, therefore,

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The adjutant general of this state is hereby authorized to receive such funds as trustee, and with the approval
