CHAPTER 464.

AN ACT to establish an official state band and making an appropriation.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The school of music of the University of Wisconsin is directed to conduct a contest, annually, for the purpose of choosing a band which shall be designated as the official state band for the ensuing year. Any regularly organized band in the state shall be eligible to enter such contest.

SECTION 2. Until such contest is held, the All Wisconsin Legion band is hereby designated as the official state band.

SECTION 3. There is appropriated from the general fund to the All Wisconsin Legion band the sum of five thousand dollars to defray a part of the expenses of such band on its trip to Paris to represent Wisconsin at the annual convention of the American Legion in September, 1927.

SECTION 4. There is also appropriated from the general fund to the Racine American Legion Drum and Bugle corps the sum of five thousand dollars to defray a part of the expenses of such corps on its trip to Paris to represent Wisconsin at the annual convention of the American Legion in September, 1927.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 465.

AN ACT to amend subsection (1) of section 29.28 of the statutes, relating to ice fishing in Eagle lake, Waukesha county and Lake Lulu, Cravath and Tripp lakes, Walworth county.
