and twenty days during the school year unless prevented by absence from the district; provided further, that any child residing more than four miles from the school of his district may attend the school of another district, in which case the home district shall pay the tuition of such child. The district shall be entitled to state aid on account of such transportation at the rate of ten cents per day for each child transported.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 518.

AN ACT to amend subsection (1) of section 96.44 of the statutes relating to registration of nursery stock dealers.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (1) of section 96.44 of the statutes is amended to read: (96.44) (1) Every dealer before * * * offering nursery stock for sale in this state, or distributing or soliciting orders for nursery stock within this state, shall secure a dealer's certificate, which he may do by furnishing an affidavit that he will buy and * * * distribute only stock which has been duly inspected and certified by a state inspector; and that he will maintain with the state entomologist a list of all sources from which he secures his stock. Upon compliance with the provisions of this section, a dealer's certificate shall be issued upon the payment of a registration fee of five dollars.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
