CHAPTER 54.

AN ACT to amend section 146.085 of the statutes, relating to locked toilets in hotels and resorts.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 146.085 of the statutes is amended to read: 146.085 If the owner or manager of any public building, other than licensed hotels and resorts, as defined in subsection (12) of section 101.01, shall keep more than fifty per centum of the toilet compartments of any public toilet room locked, he shall be fined not less than ten nor more than fifty dollars. It shall be the duty of the state board of health, the industrial commission and the railroad commission to enforce the provisions of this section within their respective jurisdictions.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 55.

AN ACT to amend paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 20.21 of the statutes, relating to the salary of the state superintendent of public instruction.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 20.21 of the statutes is amended to read: (20.21) (1) (a) To the state superintendent an annual salary of * * * *five* thousand dollars.

SECTION 2. The reduction in the salary of the state superintendent of public instruction provided in section 1 of this act shall apply to the term which begins on the first Monday in July, 1933, and all subsequent terms.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
