

WHEREAS, Economic conditions at the present time are such that any public money spent for construction projects should be utilized to give employment to the maximum number of American citizens; therefore, be it

Resolved by the Senate, the Assembly concurring, That the Legislature of Wisconsin hereby respectfully memorializes the federal officials who have charge of the letting of contracts for any federal construction project, including contracts for the purchase of equipment and materials, to exclude from consideration any foreign corporation or other bidders, and to let such contracts only to American citizens and American firms and corporations, and to require that all material used in such projects shall be manufactured in the United States of America. Be it further

Resolved, That properly attested copies of this resolution be sent to the President of the United States, to the Secretary of the Interior, and to the presiding officers of both houses of the Congress of the United States.

JOINT RESOLUTION

Memorializing the congress of the United States to enact legislation for the nomination of candidates for President and Vice-President in a primary election.

WHEREAS, The present convention system of nominating candidates for President and Vice-President is undemocratic and has often resulted in manipulation by bosses and the selection of candidates not favored by the majority of the party members; and

WHEREAS, The best method to enable the voters to control nominations is through a primary election; therefore, be it

Resolved by the Assembly, the Senate concurring, That the legislature of Wisconsin hereby memorializes the congress of the United States to enact legislation providing for the nomination of candidates for President and Vice-President through a nation-wide presidential primary election. Be it further

Resolved, That properly attested copies of this resolution be transmitted to both houses of the congress of the United States and to each Wisconsin member thereof.
