CHAPTER 92.

AN ACT to create 256.175 of the statutes, relating to declaring May 29, 1948, the hundredth anniversary of Wisconsin's admission to statehood, a legal holiday.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

256.175 of the statutes is created to read:

256.175 CENTENNIAL OF WISCONSIN'S ADMISSION TO STATEHOOD. May 29, 1948, the hundredth anniversary of Wisconsin's admission to statehood, is a legal holiday.

CHAPTER 93.

AN ACT to create 58.566 of the statutes, relating to empowering the state department of public welfare to lease state owned lands in Outagamie county to the United States of America to be used for a radio range station.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

58.566 of the statutes is created to read:

58.566 LEASE OF LANDS FOR RADIO RANGE STATION. The state department of public welfare is empowered to lease state owned lands under its control situated in section 16, town 24 north, range 18 east, Seymour township, Outagamie county, not exceeding 2 acres in extent, to the United States of America, to be used by the civil aeronautics administration for a radio range station. The terms of the lease shall be determined by the state department of public welfare and may grant to the lessee authority to erect navigational aids and other structures on such lands. Such lease shall not be effective unless approved by the governor in writing.
