CHAPTER 21.

AN ACT constituting an emergency executive budget bill, making emergency additions to certain existing appropriations for the fiscal year 1948-1949.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the general fund to the various state departments and agencies hereinafter designated, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1949, amounts to supplement the respective appropriations and for the purposes hereinafter set forth:

20.10 (9a) On the effective date of this subsection, \$35,000 as a non-lapsible appropriation to supplement the appropriation made by subsection (9) for printing and distributing Wisconsin Annotations provided for by Chapter 139, Laws of 1947.

SECTION 3. There is appropriated from the state highway fund to the various state departments hereinafter designated, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1949, amounts to supplement the respective appropriations and for the purposes hereinafter set forth:

SECTION 4. There is appropriated from the interest earnings of the state retirement system to the department hereinafter designated, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1949, an amount to supplement the appropriation and for the purposes hereinafter set forth:

SECTION 5. In addition to the amounts paid under 20.18 (2) (a) of the statutes for state aid under section 51.08 of the statutes for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1948, there is appropriated from the general fund \$260,012.15 for the purpose of increasing the rate of contribution by the state toward the expense of maintenance, care, and treatment of patients in county hospitals for the mentally infirm from \$3.25 per week to \$3.725 per week. To effect the payment of such increase, the director of budget and accounts is authorized to pay the following amounts to the following counties:

SECTION 6. In addition to the amounts paid under 20.18 (2) (a) of the statutes for state aid under 51.47 (2) of the statutes for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1948, there is appropriated from the general fund \$9,000 for the purpose of increasing the rate of contribution by the state toward the expense of maintenance, care and treatment of the tuberculous mentally ill in Sanitorium for Tuberculous Mentally Ill of Douglas County. To effect the payment of such increase the director of budget and accounts is authorized to pay the said amount to Douglas county.
